SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM: Please fill out the form available in the vestibule and turn it in to the Pastor or to the parish office. Reminder: Novus Ordo & non-practicing Catholics cannot serve as godparents, since they lack the intention of seeing to the traditional Catholic upbringing of children. Please check the Baptismal Form to see the other requirements of the Church regarding godparents. Baptisms should take place within a month after birth. Only a grave reason justifies delaying it beyond then.

1st FRIDAY Half-hour before all Masses

MATRIMONY: For practicing traditional Catholics only. Contact the pastor at least 6 months before the wedding date for marriage instructions. The best man and maid of honor of the marriage should be Catholics, since they are the official witnesses to the Sacrament of Matrimony.

HOLY COMMUNION FOR THE SICK: Please arrange with Fr. Casimir. If anyone is in danger of death, please call one of the priests immediately.

CONFIRMATION: Usually in late May/early June, but may be administered at other times when Bp. Pivarunas visits, in more urgent cases.

BLESSING OF EXPECTANT MOTHERS - Last Sunday of the month in front of the Fatima Shrine, after the blessing of religious articles.

CHILDREN'S SUNDAY CATECHISM - These classes are offered for students who do not attend St. Michael's Academy, 9:30 - 10:20 a.m. on Sundays. Information on locations, times, and teachers is posted on the bulletin board.

DOCTRINE CLASS - 6:30 - 7:30 p.m. 1st & 3rd Tuesdays of the month. Adults and older high school students welcome. We are studying the Book of Psalms.

CANDLES - You may light an eight-day candle at one of the beautiful side altars or shrines. Minimum donation is \$7. The monthly cost is \$30 for perpetual candles. Please put money in the candle donation boxes located at the BVM and Sacred Heart shrines.

STIPENDS - Stipends are not payment for spiritual benefits received, but are an offering of support for the priest who performs a Sacramental rite or ceremony. The customary stipends are as follows: Weddings - \$100, Baptisms - \$25, Mass for your intentions - \$25
